





### **HIGHLIGHTS**

- The COVID-19 vaccination campaign started in March, 2021 in accordance with the National Plan for the Introduction of Vaccination against COVID-19 (PNIV) published in the Official Bulletin No. 19, February 18, 2021
- As of the 30<sup>th</sup> of July, approximately 42.0% of the target population was vaccinated with the first dose and 5.4% of the same population with the second dose;
- By the 30thof July, 33.4% (82 637) of the general eligible population (≥ 18 years of age who do not belong to the risk groups defined in the PNIV against COVID-19) had been vaccinated with the first dose;
- The waiting period for people who had COVID-19 to get the vaccinated was reduced from 6 to 3 months;
- As of 30<sup>th</sup> of July, 83.6% of the target population with 60 years and over, were vaccinated with the first dose of the vaccine;
- As of the 30<sup>th</sup> of July, the country had received 409,050 doses of vaccines against COVID-19, through the COVAX mechanism and donations from partner countries;
- Government published Resolution 78/2021, of July 30, which approves the CABO VERDE COVID CERTIFICATE as a document proving the low risk of its holder being a patient of COVID-19.


# **NATIONAL VACCINATION RATE**

According to data, as of the 30<sup>th</sup> of July, the municipality of Ribeira Grande of Santo Antão registered the highest vaccination rate with the first dose, in relation to the eligible population.

As of the 30<sup>th</sup> of July, 155 419 people were vaccinated with the first dose, 18 108 more people than in the previous week.

# **Actions carried out**

- Publication of the National Plan for the Introduction of Vaccination against COVID-19 (https://kiosk.incv.cv/V/2021/2/18/1.1.19.3633/);
- Official publication of the establishment of the National Committee for the management of adverse events following immunization (AEFI).

- Follow-up of AEFI cases by a multi-sectoral team (which includes the National Health Directorate, Integrated Surveillance and Response Service, WHO, UNICEF, Independent Health Regulatory Authority, Office of Pharmaceutical Affairs of the MoH) and the instruments for investigation of AEFI cases;
- Expansion of vaccination centers and deployment of vaccination teams to localities, for the vaccination of the elderly and other vulnerable groups (such as isolated communities, informal workers, among others);

 Reinforcement of risk communication and community engagement for greater adherence to the vaccination campaign using various strategies in the municipalities.

According to data, as of the 30th of July, the municipality of Paul of Santo Antão registered the highest vaccination rate with the two doses, in relation to the eligible population.

As of the 30<sup>th</sup> of July, 20 153 people were vaccinated with two doses, 30548 more people than in the previous week.

As of the 23<sup>rd</sup> of July, Cabo Verde had administered 175 572 doses (42.9%) of the available vaccines.

The quantity of vaccines available in the country is sufficient to vaccinate approximately 204 535 people, which corresponds to 55.2% of the estimated population according to the PNIV.

By 30<sup>th</sup> July, 82 637 young people aged between 18 and 39 had received the 1st dose of the vaccine against COVID-19, representing 33.4% of the estimated population of this age group for this year.

#VacinaçãoCovid19 #VacinasSalvamVidas Minister of Health, Arlindo do Rosário, visited several vaccination posts against COVID-19, in the municipalities of Ribeira Grande, Porto Novo and Paúl. The visit was carried outto observe the vaccination strategies being implemented in those health structures, and learn about the progress of the campaign, in those municipalities that so far have the highest vaccination rates in the country. Until the 30th of July, Ribeira Grande de Santo Antão had 77.9%, and Porto Novo 63.4% of the eligible population vaccinated, with the first dose.
