HIGHLIGHTS

- The COVID-19 vaccination campaign started in March, 2021 in accordance with the National Plan for the Introduction of Vaccination against COVID-19 published in the Official Bulletin No. 19, February 18, 2021;
- As of the 03rd of October, 289 484 (78,2%) of the target population were vaccinated with the first dose and 146 124(39,5%) people were vaccinated with the second dose of the vaccine against Covid-19;
- By the 03rd of October, 85.8% (212 243) of the general eligible population (≥ 18 years of age who do not belong to the risk groups defined in the PNIV against COVID-19) had been vaccinated with the first dose;
- As of 03rd of October, the country had administered 435 608 (61.0%) doses of the vaccines received through the COVAX mechanism and donations from partner countries;
- Cabo Verde received a donation of 100.000 doses of the Moderna vaccine from the United States of America through the COVAX mechanism on the 03rd of October.
- Government published Resolution No. 82/2021, which approved the requirement to present a valid negative RT-PCR or antigen test result, every fourteen days, or a COVID Vaccination Certificate, by public and private service providers that provide customer services or who have direct contact with the public, as well as those who share common spaces and means of transport with them, as a public health protection measure and to reinforce vaccination efforts, in view of the COVID-19 pandemic.




According to data, as of the 03rd of October, 100% of the eligible population for vaccination of the municipalities of Paul and Ribeira Grande in Santo Antão and Tarrafal of São Nicolau had been vaccinated with the first dose.

As of the 03rd of October, 289 484 (78.2%) people were vaccinated with the first dose, 4 513 more than in the previous week.

According to data, as of the 03rd of October, eight (8) of the 22 municipalities, recorded vaccination rate with the two doses, of over 50% of the eligible population.

By the 03rd of October, 146 124 (39,5%) people were vaccinated with the two doses, 15 560 more people than in the previous week

From the 28th of June to the 03rd of October, 112 937 young people aged between 18 and 39 years had received one (1) dose of the vaccine against COVID-19, this represents 51,8% of the estimated population in this age group for the current year, (data from Census 2010 by INE).

- If you experience any symptoms after vaccination, contact the nearest health centre or call the free hotline 800 11 12 for guidance or through the website <u>https://covid19.cv/vacinas/</u> and fill in the form to report adverse effects following immunization to the Independent Health Regulatory Authority (ERIS).
- Keep the vaccination card that serves as proof of vaccination against the COVID-19.

News: United States donates 100,000 doses of vaccines to Cape Verde through the COVAX mechanism

In the evening of this Sunday, October 3, 100,000 doses of vaccines (Modern) arrived in the country, a donation from the United States of America under the COVAX Mechanism.

The arrival of this important donation at Nelson Mandela airport, aboard a TAP flight, was witnessed by the Minister of Foreign Affairs, Cooperation and Regional Integration, Rui Figueiredo Soares and Minister of Health, Arlindo do Rosário, representing the Government of Cabo Green. This act was also witnessed by representatives of the organizations of the COVAX mechanism, namely the United Nations Representative in Cape Verde, Ana Graça, the European Union Ambassador, Carla Grijó, the WHO Representative, Daniel Kertesz and the UNICEF/UNFPA Representative, Steven Ursino.
