# COVID-19 VACCINATION BULLETIN

**PERIODICITY:** Weekly

**EDITION:** Nº 14, October 20, 2021

## HIGHLIGHTS

- The COVID-19 vaccination campaign started in March, 2021 in accordance with the National Plan for the Introduction of Vaccination against COVID-19 published in the Official Bulletin No. 19, February 18, 2021;
- As of October 17, approximately 294 796 (79,6% of the target population) were vaccinated with the first dose of the vaccine against Covid-19 and 188 349 (50,9%) of the people were vaccinated with the second dose;
- By the 17<sup>th</sup> of October, 87.9% (217 446) of the general eligible population ( $\geq 18$  years of age who do not belong to the risk groups defined in the PNIV against COVID-19) had been vaccinated with the first dose;
- As of the 17<sup>th</sup> of October, the country had administered 483 145 doses (67,6%) of the vaccines received through the COVAX mechanism and donations from partner countries;
- Government published Resolution No. 82/2021, which approved the requirement to present a valid negative RT-PCR or antigen test result, every fourteen days, or a COVID Vaccination Certificate, by public and private service providers that provide customer services or who have direct contact with the public, as well as those who share common spaces and means of transport with them, as a public health protection measure and to reinforce vaccination efforts, in view of the COVID-19 pandemic. 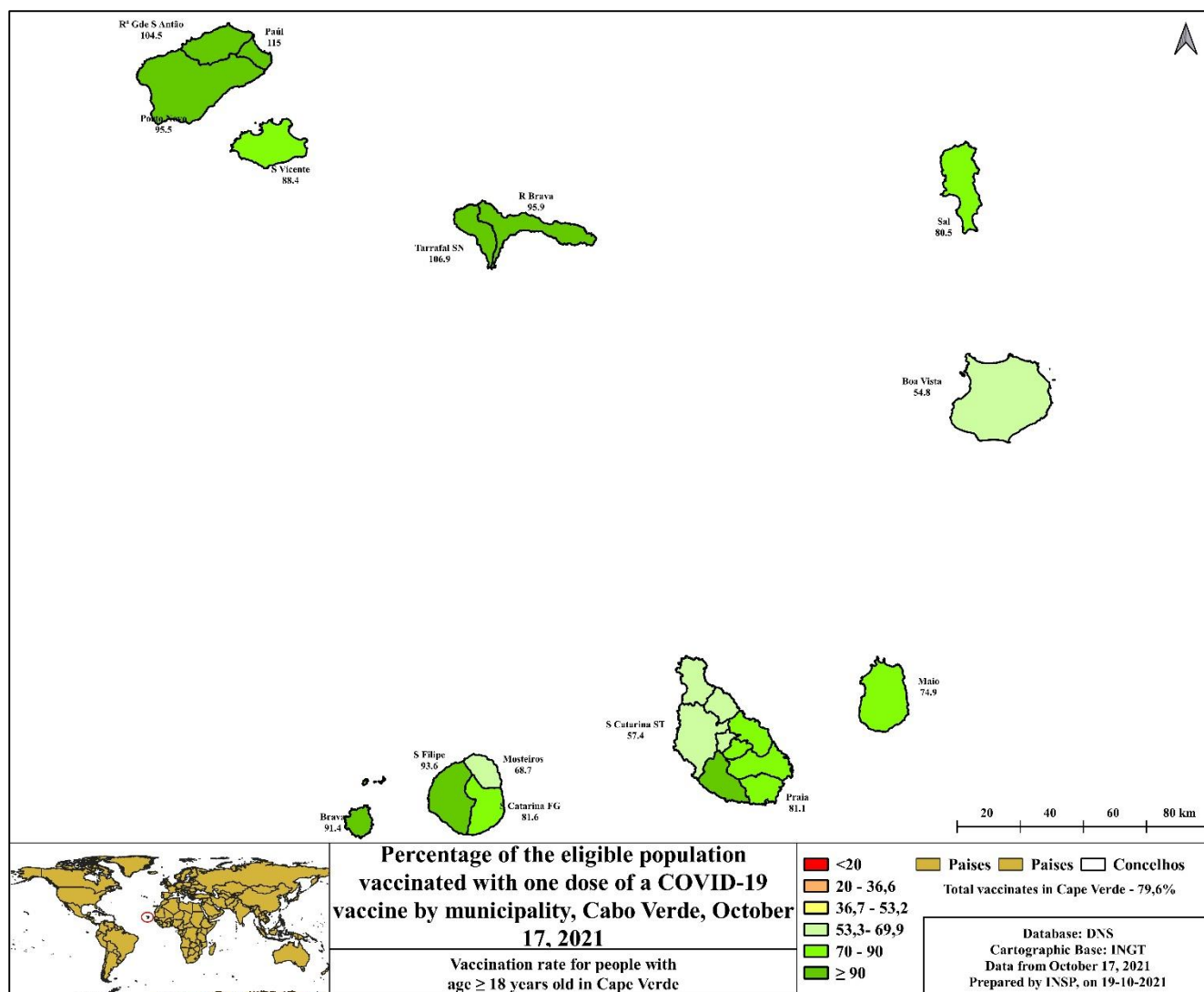

According to data, as of the 17<sup>th</sup> of October, 100% of the eligible population for vaccination of the municipalities of Paul and Tarrafal of São Nicolau and Ribeira Grande in Santo Antão had been vaccinated with the first dose.

As of the 17th of October, 294 796 (79,6%) people were vaccinated with the first dose, 2 250 more than in the previous week.

- Approval of the COVID-19 Certificate, as a document proving the low risk of its holder being an active COVID-19 patient and as a measure to facilitate free movement and the carrying out of activities in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic. Approval of issuance, verification, and acceptance of COVID Certificates from Cabo Verde and recognition of COVID Certificates issued by other countries or multilateral institutions. 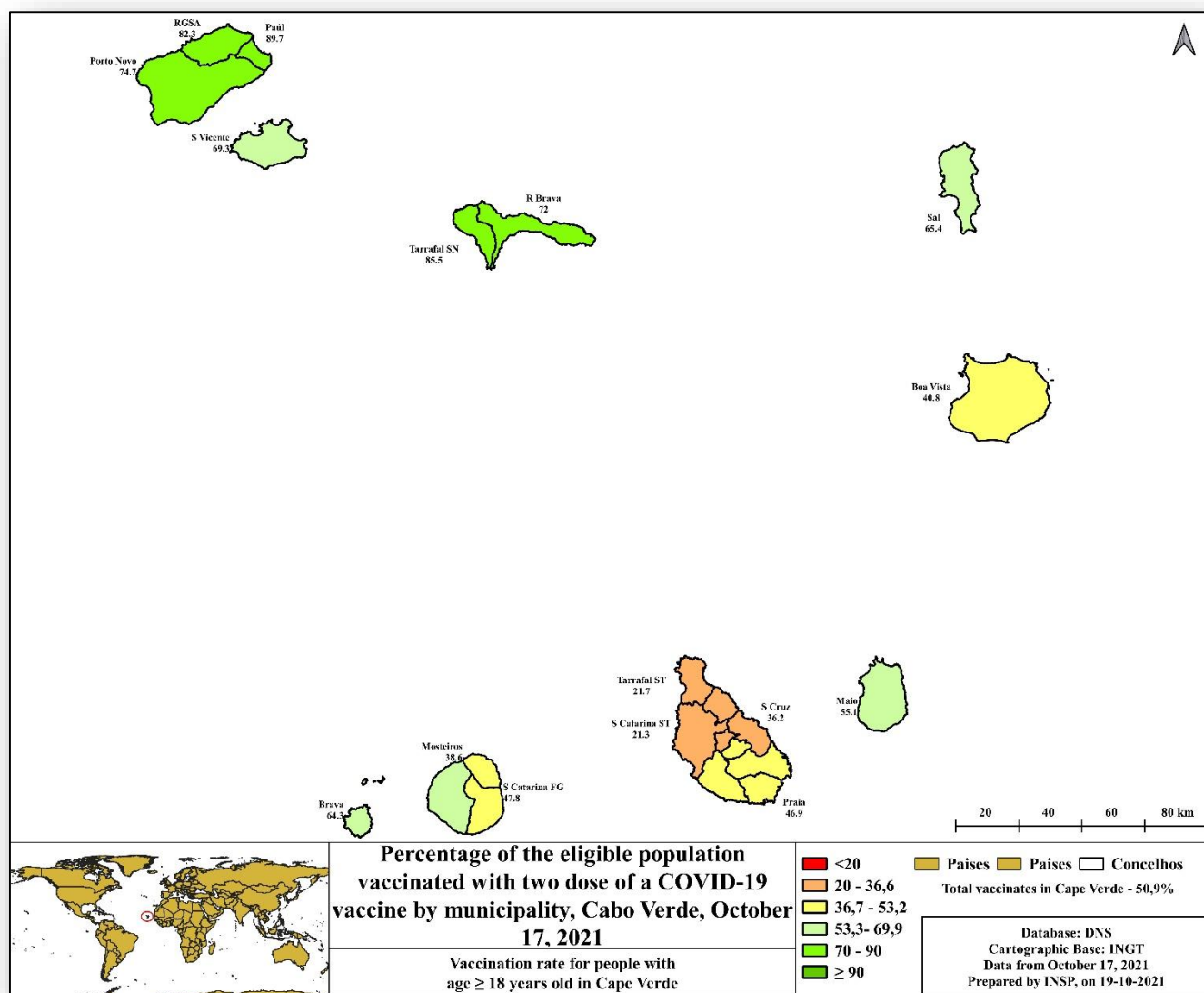

According to data, as of the 17<sup>th</sup> of October, eleven (11) of the 22 municipalities registered the vaccination rate with the two doses of 50% of their respective eligible population.

By the 17<sup>th</sup> of October, 188349 people were vaccinated with the two doses, 20259 more people than in the previous week.

From the 28<sup>th</sup> of June to the 17<sup>th</sup> of October, 114992 young people aged between 18 and 39 years had received the one (1) dose of the vaccine against COVID-19, this represents 52.7% of the estimated population in this age group for the current year, (data from Census 2010 by INE).

- If you experience any symptoms after vaccination, contact the nearest health centre or call the free hotline 800 11 12 for guidance or through the website <https://covid19.cv/vacinas/> and fill in the form to report adverse effects following immunization to the Independent Health Regulatory Authority (ERIS).
- Keep the vaccination card that serves as proof of vaccination against the COVID-19.

## News: Cape Verde with 50% of the eligible population with two doses of vaccine

The announcement was made by the National Health Director, during the press conference this Monday 18th.

Cape Verde has already managed to vaccinate 50% of its adult population with two doses of the vaccine. According to the National Health Director, Jorge Noel Barreto, until yesterday, 50.9% of the population aged 18 and over had already been completely immunized.

Jorge Noel Barreto was speaking at the usual press conference for the weekly balance of Covid-19, in the country. As he said, a total of 79.6% of the adult population has already been vaccinated with the first dose.

However, he again appealed to people to get vaccinated so that there is more group immunity, especially in the municipalities where they have not yet managed to reach the target of 70% vaccinated.

At this moment, 16 Municipalities have already reached this goal.
