





### **HIGHLIGHTS**

- The COVID-19 vaccination campaign started in March, 2021 in accordance with the National Plan for the Introduction of Vaccination against COVID-19 published in the Official Bulletin No. 19, February 18, 2021;
- As of November 07, approximately 301 797 (81,5% of the target population) were vaccinated with the first dose of the vaccine against Covid-19 and 227 580 (61,4%) of the people were vaccinated with the second dose;
- By November 07, 90,6% (224 253) of the general eligible population (≥ 18 years of age who do not belong to the risk groups defined in the PNIV against COVID-19) had been vaccinated with the first dose;
- As of November 07, the country had administered 529 377 (74,0%) of the vaccines received through the COVAX mechanism and donations from partner countries;

The Government, through Resolution No. 98/2021, declared a state of alert throughout the national territory, based on the evolution of the epidemiological situation and the vaccination process against COVID-19 and effective until January 5, 2022. <a href="https://covid19.cv/wpcontent/uploads/2021/10/bo">https://covid19.cv/wpcontent/uploads/2021/10/bo</a> 28-10-2021 106.pdf



- Publication of Resolution No. 82/2021, which approved the requirement to present a valid negative RT-PCR or antigen test result, every fourteen days, or a COVID Vaccination Certificate, by public and private service providers that provide customer services or who have direct contact with the public, as well as those who share common spaces and means of transport with them, as a public health protection measure and to reinforce vaccination


- Approval of the COVID-19 Certificate, as a document proving the low risk of its holder being an active COVID-19 patient and as a measure to facilitate free movement and the carrying out of activities in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic. - Reinforcement of the vaccination campaign in Santa Catarina of Santiago with the assembly of more than 6 mobile vaccination tents on Saturdays, in partnership with the Civil Protection, Red Cross and reinforcement with vaccination teams from other councils in the region.

According to data, as of November 07, the municipalities of Santa Catarina, São Salvador do Mundo, Tarrafal, Mosteiros and Boavista registered vaccination rates of individuals completely vaccinated below 50%, relative to the respective eligible population. By November 07, **227 580 (61,4%)** people had been vaccinated with the two doses, 8 134 more people than in the previous week.

From the June 28 to November 07, 118 145 young people aged between 18 and 39 years had received the one (1) dose of the vaccine against COVID-19, this represents **54,2%** of the estimated population in this age group for the current year, (data from Census 2010 by INE).
