# COVID-19 VACCINATION BULLETIN

**PERIODICITY:** Weekly

**EDITION:** Nº 19, November 24, 2021

## HIGHLIGHTS

- The COVID-19 vaccination campaign started in March, 2021 in accordance with the National Plan for the Introduction of Vaccination against COVID-19 published in the Official Bulletin No. 19, February 18, 2021;
- As of November 21, approximately 305 058 (82,4% of the target population) were vaccinated with the first dose of the vaccine against Covid-19 and 243 714 (65,8%) of the people were vaccinated with the second dose;
- By November 21, 86,1% (226 658) of the general eligible population ( $\geq 18$  years of age who do not belong to the risk groups defined in the PNIV against COVID-19) had been vaccinated with the first dose;
- As of November 21, the country had administered 548 772 (76,7%) of the vaccines received through the COVAX mechanism and donations from partner countries;

The Government, through Resolution No. 98/2021, declared a state of alert throughout the national territory, based on the evolution of the epidemiological situation and the vaccination process against COVID-19 and effective until January 5, 2022.

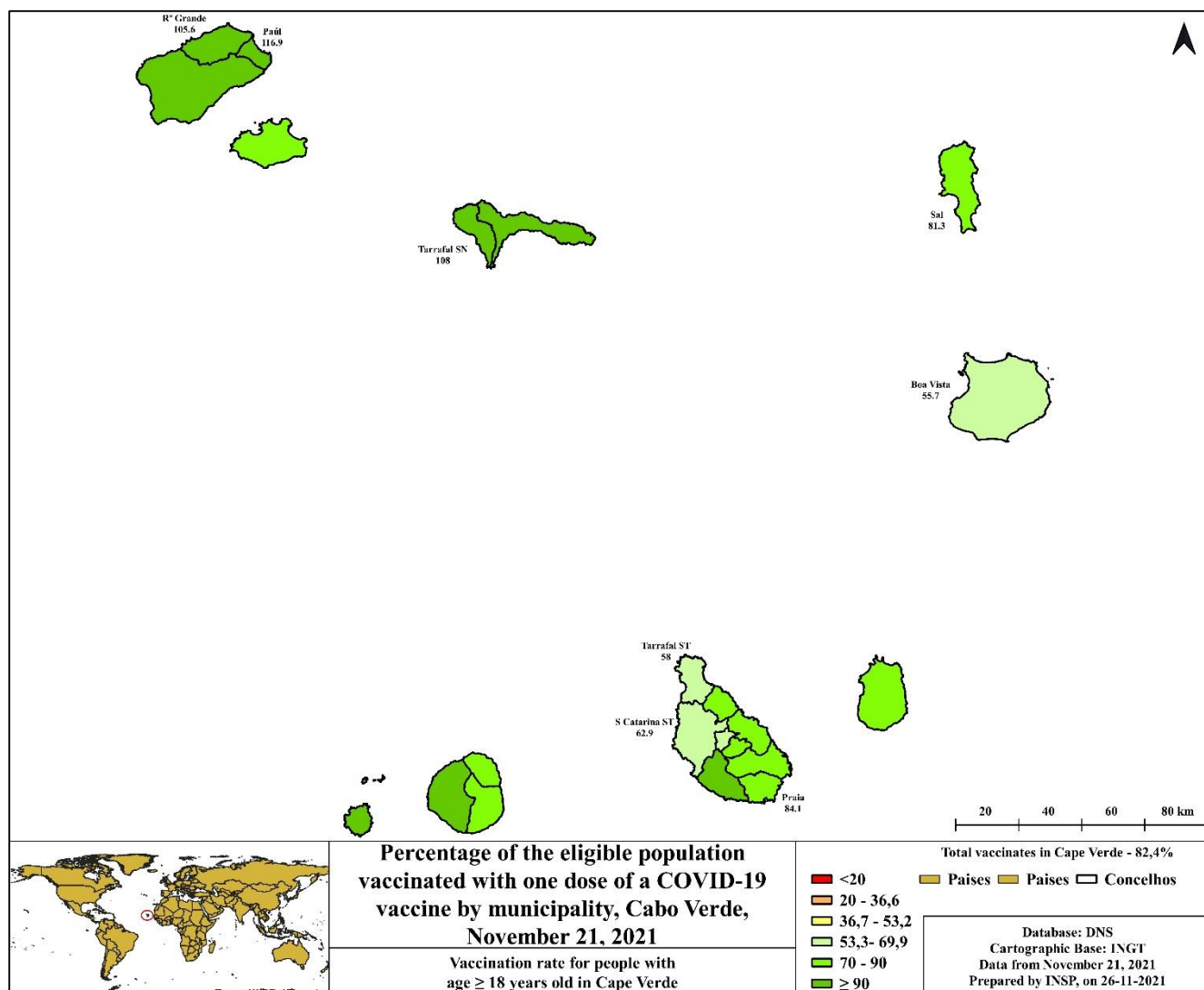

According to data, as of November 21, the municipalities of Santa Catarina, São Salvador do Mundo, Tarrafal and Boavista registered vaccination rates with the first dose below 70%.

As of November 21, 305 058 (82,4%) people were vaccinated with the first dose, 1489 more than in the previous week.

- Publication of Resolution No. 82/2021, which approved the requirement to present a valid negative RT-PCR or antigen test result, every fourteen days, or a COVID Vaccination Certificate, by public and private service providers that provide customer services or who have direct contact with the public, as well as those who share common spaces and means of transport with them, as a public health protection measure and to reinforce vaccination efforts, in view of the COVID-19 pandemic. Approval of issuance, verification, and acceptance of COVID Certificates from Cabo Verde and recognition of COVID Certificates issued by other countries or multilateral institutions. 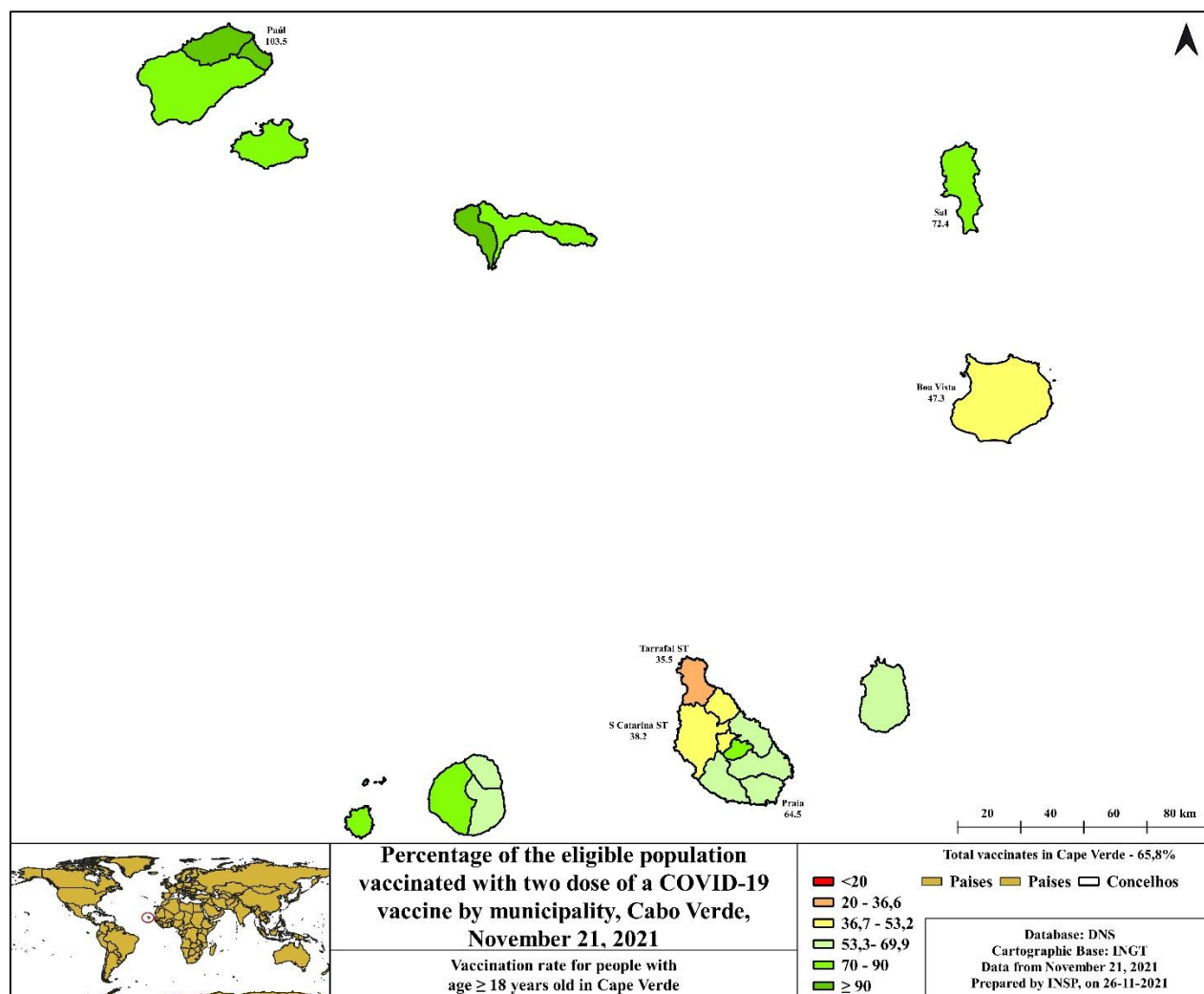

According to data, as of November 21, the municipalities of Santa Catarina, São Salvador do Mundo, Tarrafal, São Miguel and Boavista registered vaccination rates of completely vaccinated individuals below 50%, relative to the respective eligible population.

By November 21, **243 714 (65,8%)** people had been vaccinated with the two doses, 6 375 more people than in the previous week.

From the June 28 to November 21, 119 460 young people aged between 18 and 39 years had received the one (1) dose of the vaccine against COVID-19, this represents **54,8%** of the estimated population in this age group for the current year, (data from Census 2010 by INE).

- If you experience any symptoms after vaccination, contact the nearest health centre or call the free hotline 800 11 12 for guidance or through the website <https://covid19.cv/vacinas/> and fill in the form to report adverse effects following immunization to the Independent Health Regulatory Authority (ERIS).
- Keep the vaccination card that serves as proof of vaccination against the COVID-19.
