





HIGHLIGHTS

- The COVID-19 vaccination campaign started in March, 2021 in accordance with the National Plan for the Introduction of Vaccination against COVID-19 published in the Official Bulletin No. 19, February 18, 2021;
- As of December 26, approximately 310 637 (83,9% of the target population) were vaccinated with the first dose of the vaccine against Covid-19 and 261 569 (70,6%) of the people were vaccinated with the second dose;
- By December 26, 88,1% (231 947) of the general eligible population (≥ 18 years of age who do not belong to the risk groups defined in the PNIV against COVID-19) had been vaccinated with the first dose;
- As of December 26, the country had administered 572 206 (60,5%) of the vaccines received through the COVAX mechanism and donations from partner countries;
- From December 7 to 13, the country received 200 070 doses of the Pfizer vaccine from the government of the United States of America.
- On December 16, the Cabo Verde begins to vaccinate approximately 60 thousand children and adolescents between the ages of 12 and 17, against covid-19.



According to data, as of December 26, the municipalities of Santa Catarina, São Salvador do Mundo, Tarrafal and Boavista registered vaccination rates with the first dose below 70%

As of December 26, **310 637 (83,9%)** people were vaccinated with the first dose, **1 702** more than in the previous week.

Actions carried out

- Official publication of the establishment of the National Committee for the management of adverse events following immunization (AEFI).

- Publication of Resolution No. 82/2021, which approved the requirement to present a valid negative RT-PCR or antigen test result, every fourteen days, or a COVID Vaccination Certificate, by public and private service providers that provide customer services or who have direct contact with the public, as well as those who share common spaces and means of transport with them, as a public health protection measure and to reinforce vaccination efforts, in view of the COVID-19 pandemic. https://covid19.cv/wp-content/uploads/2021/08/bo 23-08-2021 81.pdf
- Approval of the COVID-19 Certificate, as a document proving the low risk of its holder being an active COVID-19 patient and as a measure to facilitate free movement and the carrying out of activities in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic. Approval of issuance, verification, and acceptance of COVID Certificates from Cabo Verde and recognition of COVID Certificates

- It is recalled that Cape Verde's Digital Vaccination Certificate (https://nhacard.gov.cv) was recognized by the European Union since December 14th. Any national who wants to travel to any country in the European Union must request or renew (re-apply) their COVID-19 certificate, through the NHA CARD platform. https://nhacard.gov.cv
- Beginning of the application of the modern vaccine for those over 18 years old throughout the national territory.
- Start of Vaccination of Adolescents from 12 to 17 years old with the Pfizer vaccine. The vaccination strategy used was vaccination in schools and high schools in the country, requiring parental authorization by signing the consent form.
- Beginning of the application of the booster dose or 3rd dose to people over 60 years of age, people with chronic illnesses, Health Professionals, Firefighters, Civil Protection professionals, professionals at entry points, Police, Military personnel, teachers and support staff at schools, Civil Aviation and Maritime professionals as well as workers in the Tourism sector. According to data, as of December 26, the municipalities of Boavista, Sao Miguel, São Salvador do Mundo, Santa Catarina e Tarrafal, registered vaccination rates of completely vaccinated individuals below 50%, relative to the respective eligible population.

By December 05, **261 569 (70,6%)** people had been vaccinated with the two doses, 3 671 more people than in the previous week.




Figure 2. Percentage of the eligible population vaccinated with two dose of a COVID-19 vaccine by municipality, Cabo Verde, December 26, 2021

From the June 28 to December 26, **123 540** young people aged between 18 and 39 years had received the one (1) dose of the vaccine against COVID-19, this represents **56,6%** of the estimated population in this age group for the current year, (data from Census 2010 by INE).

- Vaccinated people must comply with the recommended preventive measures: social distancing, use of masks, hand hygiene, and other recommendations to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

 the free hotline 800 11 12 for guidance or through the website
 https://covid19.cv/vacinas/ and fill in the form to report adverse effects following
 immunization to the Independent Health Regulatory Authority (ERIS).
- Keep the vaccination card that serves as proof of vaccination against the COVID-19.
- You can request and receive your COVID Certificate through the platform www.nhacard.cv.
 In case of any difficulties, complaint could be sent on the same platform
 https://nhacard.gov.cv/reclamation or contact the nearest health centre.
- People vaccinated with the first dose and who have already completed 2 months should go to the nearest vaccination posts to get their second dose of vaccine.
